Paws and Listen to your animals

Best Deal ... Communicating with animals always seemed complicated to me. I remember like it was yesterday ... but not, well, really.

During West Coast Newspapers' July 4 workshop at Silver Ridge, Northridge last week, where beauty blogger, author of *Ames and Love* to the rescue of your animals and animal communication, shared the wisdom that it really is not that difficult at all.

After hearing a few general comments she had with her animal friends, she showed the group how to meditate to make communication with your animal easier.

"Animals respond to happiness, feelings and thoughts that come out. They don't use a specific language but rather sense the owner's feelings and thoughts. If you want your dog to stop jumping up when greeting people, it won't help to say 'stop, jumping up' because they receive the pleasure of their jumping up."

"They don't understand 'stop' and that's it is the right thing to do. They will understand the pleasure thought of them with all four paws on the ground."

the ground with a few practice sessions at your feet. Your animal will stop doing that. You can communicate telepathically with your animals so just before leaving work, send them a message that you are leaving and they will see you a little later. It is like a surprise if they know, but it's not. Never ask a question if you don't want to hear the answer. Animals will always tell the truth, so name what. That, they say after public you need help you, if you need it."

Each visitor had to bring a photo along of their pet and after some recommendations, we with a picture, "read" or "perceived" messages to the questions that were always returned to know.

"It is always necessary to ask permission before communicating with your pet because they might be busy. It is also important to acknowledge them after you've communicated."

Some of the people managed to receive a message and, with great excitement, passed it on to the owner who was equally excited.
